

## How do I get access?

Any customer can logon with a computer running the Windows XP operating system and that is equipped with an 802.11b wireless chipset, network card, USB antenna or a power over Ethernet outdoor wireless antenna solution.

## Where is BWE's coverage area?

BWE's access point is located near Baseline and Greenfield in Gilbert, AZ. Any customer living south of Baseline and east of Greenfield should be able to get a good signal. However, customers more than 1,500 feet from the access point may need clear line of site between their antenna and our access point. ## Where can you buy equipment?

Wireless 802.11b networking equipment can purchased at any local computer hardware store. ## How does it work?

BWE has located a wireless transmitter, also known as an access point, on a tower a little higher than a two-story house. Users located near the access point use an 802.11b wireless antenna to talk to the network. The first time you logon you will be required to set up a BWE account and select a username and password. There will be no monthly fee during the test.

If you have trouble finding the BWE network in the Available Wireless Networks menu, your computer may be located too far away from the access point to receive a strong signal. There may also be an obstacle that is blocking the path between your location and our access point. If you're having trouble, call us and we will help you determine whether or not it is possible to receive our wireless signal.
